2. Applicable Aircraft: Boeing 767-300ERs (9 planes scheduled in FY2015)

Boeing 787-8s (3 planes scheduled in FY2015)

Continue to introduce more 787-8s with JAL SKY Wi-Fi service in and after FY2016.

3. Applicable Routes: Europe, North America and long-haul Asia routes

4. International in-flight internet service (Paid service):
