## JAL Continues International Fare Fuel Surcharge at Current Rates for Tickets Issued in August and September 2024

Tokyo, JAPAN – Japan Airlines (JAL) has announced the continuation of the current fuel surcharge on international passenger tickets purchased in Japan between August 1 and September 30, 2024.

JAL sets fuel surcharge levels bimonthly based on the two-month average price of Singapore kerosene-type jet fuel. The price of Singapore kerosene-type jet fuel during the two-month period of April and May 2024 averaged USD99.41 per barrel, which accounted for JPY15,387 in the average exchange rate of JPY/USD 154.78 during the same period.

As a result, with reference to the fuel surcharge benchmark list for FY2024, this will continue to correspond to Zone J from August to September 2024.
