



## **JAL Group Announces FY2025 Summer Schedule on International Cargo Network**

Tokyo, JAPAN – The JAL Group has announced the Summer schedule of its international cargo freighters for the fiscal year 2025.

With the introduction of a third Boeing 767 freighter, JAL plans to expand its operations as follows to further meet customer demand:

- **New Route to Hanoi:** Commencing March 30, JAL will launch a new cargo service to Hanoi, a city experiencing significant growth in high-tech industries. This marks the first regular Southeast Asian route since the resumption of freighter operations.
- **Increased Frequencies:** Flight frequencies to Hong Kong will be increased to six times a week, and to Shanghai, three times a week.
- **New Taipei Round-Trip Route:** A new round-trip cargo route between Narita and Taipei (Taoyuan) will be established, with five flights a week.
