



JAL Group Announces Updates for FY2025 Summer Schedule on International Cargo Network

Tokyo, JAPAN – The JAL Group has announced updates to its FY2025 Summer schedule of its international cargo freighters, effective from May 8th.

- Flight frequencies to Tianjin will be increased to three times a week, and to Taipei, once a week.
- A new round-trip cargo route between Narita and Incheon will be established, with once a week.
