(Update) Flight Cancellations Regarding Tokyo (Haneda) – Doha Route No.2

Operational Notes for Tokyo (Haneda) – Doha Flights

On June 24, 2025, at approximately 1:00 AM JST, the airspace over Qatar was temporarily closed for safety reasons.

Although restrictions on the airspace surrounding Qatar have since been lifted, flight operations for JL59/50 (Tokyo (Haneda) – Doha) will remain suspended until it is confirmed that sufficient safety measures are ensured under the current situation in the Middle East.
