Japan Airlines Increases Flight Options for Customers Traveling between Tokyo (Haneda) and New York (JFK)

~JAL to Codeshare on American Airlines' New HND - JFK Service~

Japan Airlines' Pacific Joint Business partner (*), American Airlines is launching new nonstop service on the Tokyo Haneda (HND) - New York (JFK) route from June 28, 2024. Today, JAL announced that it will add its code to the new flights.


Customers will now have the option to choose from three daily flights between the two cities, including two daily nonstop flights operated by JAL. Being the only U.S. carrier to fly between New York and Tokyo, American Airlines' new service will also provide customers with enhanced connectivity to destinations in the United States, Central and South America via New York.
